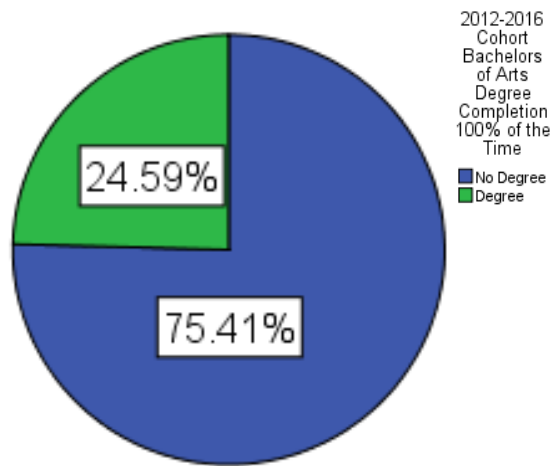
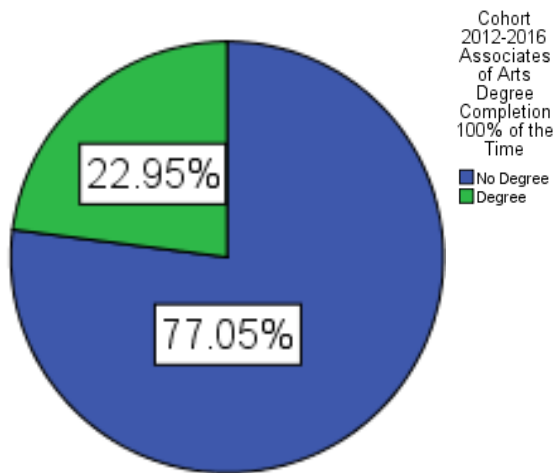

- The table reflects retention rates from 2011-2016 for our first time-first year cohorts.
- The first year to second year trend is nearly a 50 percent drop.
- However, the trend from our third year students to our fourth year student retention rate is 73% or higher.

- AGR shows a similar comparison for the AA and BA.
- This data includes both transfer and non-transfer data.

2012 -2016 Year Transfer Students Graduation Rates

- CLC transfer student AA candidates graduated in 100% of the time.
- The student retention rate for our transfer students who pursued and AA degree is 75%.
- Student retention for those pursuing their BA is 100%.
- The BA graduation rate is 66%.
